Gwinnett outdoor burning

Burning of yard waste is allowed during some days of the week until April 30, with specific restrictions (Mon-Sat daylight hours only, under close supervision, at least 50 ft. from structures, small fires only, and not on windy days, wet days, and other special situations). Check before you light up to be sure it's a burn day, at www.gwinnettfiremarshal.com. **To report unlawful burning, call 678.518.4980, or dial 911.**

Crime Watch

There have been several burglaries near the neighborhood since our November report, one actually on Timber Glen and another on Wheatley. Please check your security systems, get to know your neighbors (especially those who are at home during the day), and watch out for each other.

If you'd like to track reported crimes, visit crimemapping.com and choose

our county, then click "Receive crime alerts" on the top bar of the page. They'll email you 2 or 3 times a week as crimes are reported in the vicinity you choose.
