We had limited luminary placement this year and, with our limited budget, are considering discontinuing the luminaries moving forward. If you are passionate about these please let us know with an email!




May 18 Spring Meeting

Please Clean Out Your Street Gutters of Debris

Residents are responsible for cleaning the gutters and street that adjoin their property. Roadside gutters must be kept clear at all times to allow for the free flow of rainwater. And, if a storm drain is on your property, it is your job to keep it clear as well. Anyone blowing leaves should blow them <u>away</u> from rain gutters and storm drains.

Burning ban May 1- Sept 30

The Georgia Department of Natural Resources has issued a ban on open burning May 1 – September 30 of each year. Fifty-four counties in Georgia (including Gwinnett Country) are affected. During this time, you may not burn leaves, tree limbs, or other yard waste.
