You may have noticed damage to a bush near the fire hydrant across from the main entrance sign. County water department personnel sprayed with herbicide the plantings around the fire hydrant for easier access in an emergency. Our landscaping service has trimmed back the damaged bush and added flowers. This is a heads-up for all of us to keep our plantings trimmed back from the fire hydrants. Otherwise they may be removed in a less-thanoptimal fashion.
