A local realtor shares tips about home values

Making money on your home is key to most homeowners. A home is the largest single investment average people make, and most are assuming they will make a profit when they sell.

The obvious things about home ownership that make or save you money...

- 1. Saving on your taxes.
- 2. As mortgage payments are made over the years, your equity rises and your debt falls.
- 3. Homes usually appreciate in value under normal conditions. Wait for a seller's market.
- 4. Market your home at a high price instead of what your naive neighbors or low balling agents recommend. Educate yourself--go with your gut and go high. You will never get a high price if you don't ask for it.

The obvious things that keep your home values the highest...

- 1. Keep your home maintained and looking good the whole time that you live there.
- 2. Manicured lawns and flower beds say, "I love my home." People notice when homes are not loved.
- 3. Store items in rear of home. Homes that are cluttered, inside or out, do not sell.
- 4. Keep your home clean and especially clean it well when you are selling it. Clean homes sell for 3 to 4% more than dirty ones.
- 5. You are not in charge of when your home sells; buyers are. Keep in mind that your role is to do as much as possible to make your home attractive and keep it exposed. The rest, you do not control.

Remember that you are partners with your neighbors in keeping the equity you have earned. Your house reflects on theirs and theirs on yours!

We have had 1 recent foreclosure in Deerbrook, which sold at 100% of the asking price (\$137K) in 8 days.

Foreclosures can affect all of our home values, so it's even more important to keep your home well maintained!
